FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOL REGISTRATIONS (K-5): Registration for elementary students new to the Lincoln Public Schools will be accepted at their neighborhood elementary school.

All packets must be completely filled out and include a copy of parent's driver's license or state issued ID, a copy of the child's birth certificate, copies of proofs of residency, notarized affidavits and a recent physical including immunization records with month, date and year of shots. Any incomplete registration packets will delay the registration process.

Enrollment is based on space availability.
