It is the policy of the Lincoln School Committee that all relationships between the Lincoln Teachers' Association, the Lincoln School Department non-certified employee Local 2671, the Lincoln School Department administrative staff and the Lincoln School Committee will be conducted through the Superintendent of Schools.

It is understood that problems and issues not resolved to the satisfaction of the staff may be appealed, in writing, to the School Committee. Such appeal may be accepted or rejected. If an appeal is accepted, it will be heard by the full School Committee at either an open meeting or in executive session depending on the nature of the issue. Collective Bargaining Agreement contractual language regarding grievance procedures is exempted from this School Committee policy.
